## Human Trafficking Statistics



- Michigan ranks in the top when there are sweeps across the nation.
- Michigan came up SECOND IN THE NUMBER OF JUVENILES recovered from sex trading in a 2013 FBI sting *Mica Abolitionist Project*

- \$32 Billion – estimated profits from Human Trafficking globally each year. This is more than Google, Starbuc Nike UNICEF
- There is an estimated 186 – 322 people enslaved in Livingston County Michigan. *USCountyPopulation.com*
- The average age range of a child first forced into prostitution is 11 – 14. *Federal Bureau of Investigation*
- One in three street prostitutes are less than 18. *National Center for Missing and Exploited Children.*
- Women and children constitute 80 percent of trafficking victims. *In Our Backyard by Nita Belles*
- Made in America does not guarantee that the product isn't made, at least in some part, by slave labor. *In Our Back by Nita Belies*
- LCAP has partnered with the first and only survivor home for trafficked women and their children in Livingston Cou
- The risk of being trafficked is 80% higer for a homeless child than a child with a home. *Ben Reaoch, Thre n's ( Church, Pittsburg,PA*
- There are 41,942 sex offenders in Michigan *Dr Bonita Laudeman, Human Trafficking Expert, Author, Chaplain*
- There are 150 girls under the age of 18 being sold into sexual slavery every month in Michigan. *Michigan State Se, Judy Emmons*
